### Reflection on 2020/21

As we all know 2020 & 2021 have been difficult years. The Hall was forced to close in late March 2020 due to COVID and started to re-open albeit with restrictions from May 2021 when we held a much awaited & successful Scarecrow Trail. Since then, as restrictions began to ease, we have held a number of bookswap & coffee mornings, a great Tractor Run and the Arts & Crafts Fair in November. The weekly community group activities gradually restarted in July and are now back at full strength. During lockdown the committee has still operated remotely and put in place a number of improvements to the Hall. These include repair of the front wall, expansion of the fire alarm now covering the main hall & kitchen, installation of carbon monoxide alarms, replacement of old incandescent bulbs with LEDs, repairs to our stove and the complete refurbishment of our large patio area. These projects have been kindly supported financially by the West Craven Area Committee and Kelbrook & Sough Parish Council. Particular thanks must go to Lancashire Environmental Fund whose generous grant enabled us to refurbish our patio resulting in a safe, usable outdoor area.
