Defibrillator

It's important for everyone to know that there is a defibrillator available in the villages of Kelbrook & Sough. The one in Kelbrook is located on the front wall of the village hall (Dotcliffe Road) & the one in Sough is located on the front of the building on RHS of Sough Park viewed from the park entrance.

In an emergency you must call 999. The call handler will ask a series of questions & if a heart condition is suspected they will ask if there is a defibrillator available. Depending on the severity of the situation you may be asked to collect the defibrillator to enable you to use the equipment. The call handler will talk you through all the actions necessary to treat the patient until such time as the Emergency services arrive.
