## Hopeful return of the Luncheon Club

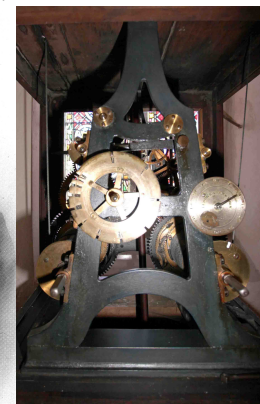
